Course Description

Portions of the Illinois SAFE-T Act mandate that officers receive 30 hours of training every three years in **Use of Force**, to include hands on scenario-based role-playing, de-escalation and high-risk traffic stops. This class will satisfy 24 of those 30 hours of mandated training. This fast-paced training will be devoted primarily to hands on, scenario-based, role play training involving force-on-force exercises. A 6-hour course covering **Use of Force Law** will be offered in a separate training class.

Course Objectives

- Explain why high-risk patrol operations were developed and the need for them to be integrated into their daily patrol activities.
- Identify and discuss use-of-force and safety priority issues related to high-risk patrol incidents, including immediate defense of life, law, police, procedure, and established safety priorities.
- Describe the appropriate and necessary equipment to be used when conducting these types of operations, including weapons and ammunition and uniform/identification requirements.
- Demonstrate practical knowledge and performance ability while conducting high-risk patrol operations, as well as movement formations, verbal skills, firearms handling/deployment skills, and working as a team.
- Demonstrate proper Use of Force and De-Escalation techniques.
- Properly perform building searches & room clearing
- Properly take a suspect into physical custody.
- Demonstrate proper use of cover, concealment, and time.
- Properly perform High-Risk traffic stops.
- Perform proper vehicle clearing.

Instructor

MTU 15 Field Assistant Dave Rednour will be the primary instructor. He has completed a series of classes involving 160 hours of training to become a Master Active Threat Instructor. Dave will be assisted by various equally qualified Active Threat instructors.

Equipment Requirements

Attendees are required to provide safety glasses, jacket, or heavy long sleeve shirt (for Simunition training), duty gear, ballistic vest or outer carrier, and AR-15 rifle (if carried on duty).

Mandates Met by This Training

This course is pending ILETSB approval and might be approved for the following mandates: 24 of the required 30 hours of Use of force Training.
