Course Description				
<p>This course is designed to train officers in the fundamentals and tactical skill sets required during high-risk patrol operations. The primary focus of this training is to build the officers skills designed to minimize the level of force required when making an arrest, whenever safe and feasible to do so.</p> <p>Through dynamic scenario-based role-playing training this course will provide officers with the foundational knowledge, specialized tactical skill sets, and strategic understanding to be able to manage and perform the following critical high-risk patrol functions: Use of Force and De-escalation techniques, Cover and Concealment, High Risk Traffic Stops, and Arrest Team Tactics.</p> <p><b>Officers must attend the Use of Force/ De-escalation Techniques class (Day 1) prior to attending this class.</b></p>				
Course Objectives				
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Explain why high-risk patrol operations were developed and the need for them to be integrated into their daily patrol activities.</li><li>• Identify and discuss use-of-force and safety priority issues related to high-risk patrol incidents, including immediate defense of life, law, police, procedure, and established safety priorities.</li><li>• Describe the appropriate and necessary equipment to be used when conducting these types of operations, including weapons and ammunition and uniform/identification requirements.</li><li>• Demonstrate practical knowledge and performance ability while conducting high-risk patrol operations, as well as movement formations, verbal skills, firearms handling/deployment skills, and working as a team.</li><li>• Demonstrate proper Use of Force and De-Escalation techniques.</li><li>• Properly perform building searches &amp; room clearing</li><li>• Properly take a suspect into physical custody.</li><li>• Demonstrate proper use of cover, concealment, and time.</li><li>• Properly perform High-Risk traffic stops.</li></ul>
