Course Description

This course will cover basic CPR practices and AED operation. This class will certify students in CPR and AED, teach students how to recognize symptoms of choking and heart attack. If the students want a card indicating their training and certification, there will be a \$20 fee for the card, to be paid at the class.

Course Objectives

- Describe the importance of high-quality CPR and its impact on survival
- Describe all of the steps of the Chains of Survival and apply the related BLS concepts
- Recognize the signs of someone needing CPR
- Perform high-quality CPR on adults, children and infants
- Describe the importance of early use of an AED
- Provide effective ventilation by barrier device
- Multi-rescuer resuscitation and CPR
- Describe the technique for relief of foreign-body airway obstruction for adult, child and infant

Instructors

Stephen Durbin and others will provide detailed instruction and scenario based training on how to properly administer CPR and utilize an AED on someone experiencing cardiac arrest.
