Course Description

This course is designed to train officers in the fundamentals and tactical skill sets required during high-risk patrol operations. The primary focus of this training is to build the officers skills designed to minimize the level of force required when making an arrest, whenever safe and feasible to do so.

Through dynamic scenario-based role-playing training this course will provide officers with the foundational knowledge, specialized tactical skill sets, and strategic understanding to be able to manage and perform the following critical high-risk patrol functions: Use of Force and De-escalation techniques, Building searches and Arrest team tactics.

Each Student will be put in individual Scenarios where they will have opportunity to practice appropriate Use of Force and De-escalation techniques. Students will be Instructed on Building Searches, Room Clearing and Arrest Team tactics. Students will then be assigned to team scenarios where they will have the opportunity to practice appropriate use of force and De-escalation techniques.

"Bring Lunch"

This class is a pre-requisite for the De-escalation High Risk Stop/ Use of Force Class (Day 2).

Course Objectives

- Describe the appropriate and necessary equipment to be used when conducting these types of operations, including weapons and ammunition and uniform/identification requirements.
- Demonstrate proper Use of Force and De-Escalation techniques.
- Properly perform building searches & room clearing
- Properly take a suspect into physical custody.
- Demonstrate proper use of cover, concealment, and time.
- Properly perform High-Risk traffic stops.
- Perform proper vehicle clearing.
