This course is designed to show officers how to proactively use sex offender registration and restriction violations as an intelligence and street level enforcement tool. This program will provide students with a standardized approach to conducting address verification checks and investigating sex offender complaints within their communities while addressing problems or issues specifically related to sex offender registration or restriction investigations.
