<p>Compliance checks are a foundation of any good alcohol enforcement initiative. These checks must be done fairly and correctly to encourage compliance with alcohol service laws. This 4-hour class is for police supervisors responsible for conducting compliance testing for alcohol & tobacco laws. This is a comprehensive class on how to properly conduct police compliance testing operations to effectively enforce age restrictions on liquor (also meets statutory minimum training standard for Tobacco).</p> <p>This program includes sample police policy and procedures, case law, and national guidelines to ensure police compliance testing passes judicial review. Specific recommendations are given to ensure community, media, and merchant support for your enforcement program. The multi-media presentation covers national policy and court rulings on proper compliance testing operations.</p>
