Course Description

The Medical Priority Dispatch System is a unified system used to dispatch appropriate aid to medical emergencies including systematized caller interrogation and pre-arrival instructions. establishes a universal standard for emergency dispatchers taking calls for a broad range of field and triage response—which may include drowning, stabbing, gunshot wounds, and much more—all while the first responders are en route.

Tested over hundreds of millions of calls since 1979, MPDS includes 36 protocols that are continually updated as per recommendations and research made by top medical professionals and associations.

Course Objectives

This class will provide the telecommunicator with the tools needed to successfully categorize and prioritize EMS incidents by assigning a number-letter-number format code to each type of incident. This training is meant to:

- ✓ Instruct telecommunicators how to obtain exact location & type of emergency.
- ✓ Enable telecommunicators to identify chief complaint.
- ✓ Triage patients over the telephone.
- ✓ Provide proven protocols for determining correct response.
- ✓ Teach telecommunicators how to provide pre-arrival instructions
