### Course Description

This course will measure practical marksmanship skills with the “Handgun”. The results of this course of fire will be documented with MTU 15 and officers successfully completing the course will receive a state “*Certificate of Qualification*”. The Course-of-Fire for this qualification is that which has been approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB) for in-service handgun qualification. There will also be a review of the *ILETSB Use of Force* brochure covering statutory and constitutional considerations in peace officers use of deadly force in making arrest.

- ✓ Safe weapon handling
- ✓ Accuracy & proficiency with the handgun

### Requirements

Officers participating in this qualification course must have successfully completed the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board approved 40-hour Mandatory Firearms Training. Officers will participate in this qualification exercise on a “first come/first serve basis”. It will take approximately one hour to complete the course which will commence at the top of each hour.

- ✓ Duty Handgun: Semi-auto pistol with 3 magazines
- ✓ Ammunition: 30 rounds of factory new or commercially re-manufactured **only!**
- ✓ Duty belt gear
- ✓ Eye Protection
- ✓ Hearing Protection
