This 24 Hours participatory calculated use of force training is designed to familiarize the participants of their responsibilities when responding as a tactical unit to a single inmate or multiple inmate cell extraction (forced cell move) with basic tactical equipment and control techniques. Each member of the team must know their own responsibility and everyone else's to perform as a cohesive unit.
