Course Description

This course will measure practical marksmanship skills with the Handgun and Patrol Rifle. The results of this course-of-fire will be documented with MTU 15 and officers successfully completing the course will receive a state "Certificate of Qualification". The course-of-fire for this qualification is that which has been approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board for our Certified 2-Day Basic Patrol Rifle course.

Course Objectives

Students must demonstrate:

- ✓ Safe weapon handling
- ✓ **Firearms Instructors must qualify with a minimum of 90% with the handgun and the rifle.**

Instructor

MTU 15 Assistant Director Doug Wilson has over 24 years of police experience. Doug is an Active Threat Master Instructor, Firearms Instructor, Red Dot Pistol Instructor, Use of Force Instructor, EEVOC Instructor, TASER Instructor and has been a supervisor, FTO, and Special Response Team member/sniper. Requirements

Officers participating in this qualification course must be ILETSB approved Firearms Instructors who have submitted their Form C and plan to teach or contract for MTU 15 as firearms instructors or are going to conduct In-Service firearms qualifications and training at their departments via MTU 15.

Required Student Equipment:

- ✓ Rifle or Carbine chambered in .223 Rem. or 5.56 mm, semi-auto, detachable box magazine
- ✓ Sling
- ✓ Three 20- or 30- round magazines
- ✓ Duty handgun and three magazines
- ✓ 60 rounds of factory ammunition for the rifle and the handgun
- ✓ Sling
- ✓ Shooting glasses
- ✓ Ear Protection
