This course shall define roles, responsibilities, and operational procedures to support a rapid deployment rescue task force (RTF) response. RTF teams will operate in the warm zone, rapidly performing critical lifesaving medical procedures and triage under the force protection of law enforcement. The RTF shall continue progressing forward in the designated warm zone until all victims have been triaged and accounted for.
