Course Description

This course is to prepare law enforcement officers to be effective trainers. It will focus on teaching and the preparation of proper training documentation. Students will participate in practice public presentations.

Course Objectives

- A trainer's legal professional responsibilities to their agency and attendees.
- How to assess trainee needs & abilities to research & write training materials with fitted methods.
- How and why the trainer must build a communication climate for learning.
- How to write achievable learning objectives, a lesson plan, a source document, a course synopsis, and test questions—clarifying the legal and practical purposes and responsibilities of each.
- Methods for increasing public speaking confidence and reducing nervousness, towards increasing quality training. Students give a 3-minute presentation, a panel presentation, & final teaching project.
- The advantages & disadvantages of PowerPoint slides.
- How to test fairly and to accurately measure training goals.
The purpose of training evaluation & how to write an evaluation that increases instructor awareness.
