Requirements

Officers participating in this qualification course must have successfully completed the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board approved 40-hour Mandatory Firearms Training. Officers will participate in this qualification exercise on a "first come/first serve basis". It will take approximately one hour to complete the course which will commence at the top of each hour.

- ✓ Duty Handgun: Semi-auto pistol with 3 magazines
- ✓ Ammunition: 30 rounds of factory new or commercially re-manufactured **only!**
- ✓ Duty belt gear
- ✓ Eye Protection
- ✓ Hearing Protection
