<p>Illinois 95th General Assembly Resolution 0051 requires <i>Manufacturer's</i> Certification on Elector-Muscular Disruption Technology (EMDT) Employed by Illinois Law Enforcement and Correctional Officers. <u>TASER International</u> requires that users of the TASER Conducted Electrical Weapon (CEW) device take a certification course prior to carrying the TASER. That certification expires one year from the date of issue.</p> <p>This 3-hour class is for the re-certification of those officers who have previously received the full 8-hour <u>TASER Conducted Electrical Weapon Certification</u> class.</p>
