Course Description

This training will begin with a classroom presentation emphasizing the potential dangers of pursuit, and other emergency vehicle response situations. Following the classroom portion, this course is entirely hands-on, behind-the-wheel, on a state-of-the-art Emergency & Evasive Vehicle Operator driving track, including a skid-pad and features for off-road recovery maneuvers.

Course Objectives

Upon completion of this class students will be able to properly and safely perform the following:

- ✓ Controlled slalom and vehicle handling on the serpentine course
- ✓ Controlled braking
- ✓ Backing procedures
- ✓ Emergency off-road recovery
- ✓ Skid recovery
- ✓ Evasive techniques to avoid traffic crashes
- ✓ Good defensive driving techniques

Additional Information

Officers should bring an agency squad car to practice various low-speed maneuvers. Exercises involving high-speed recovery maneuvers will be done in vehicles provided by the SIU Safety Center.
