The removal and disposal of vehicles can be burdensome police duty that can involve significant liability if not handled correctly. Therefore, a properly trained “vehicle reclamation officer” can be a wise investment for police agencies to help lower liability risks and possible storage costs.

The goal of this program is to train officers for the complex duties involved in understanding and processing vehicles that are abandoned, junked, towed, seized & otherwise left unattended by their owners.

- ✓ Legal review of abandoned/unclaimed vehicles
- ✓ Processing of vehicle (towed or seized)
- ✓ Identification of persons properly licensed to possess salvage vehicles
- ✓ Liability in relation to towing policies based on current case law
