Course Description

An analysis of the evolution of the criminal offense of Driving Under the Influence is of vital interest to all Illinois law enforcement agencies. Few other sections of the IVC command the attention of law enforcement officers and the public as does DUI. The cost of the consequences of committing this offense to the public in time and money, not to mention lives, is nearly incalculable. Consequently, this DUI – Legal Considerations presentation will analyze the current status of the offense of DUI in Illinois. It will identify all Illinois statutory provisions, both criminal and civil, that have been created to deal with this offense. Illinois case law will be analyzed to guide law enforcement officers in their task of understanding and enforcing the DUI statutes. Finally, the policy decisions of Law Enforcement agencies will be analyzed and discussed.

Course Objectives

A complete update of the legal considerations for Illinois Law Enforcement Officers of for DUI enforcement:

- ✓ An analysis of the Illinois status for the offense of Driving Under the Influence.
- ✓ The duties, authorities, and responsibilities of Illinois Law Enforcement Officers with respect to all DUI related statutory provisions will be identified and discussed.
- ✓ An analysis of the Implied Consent statute and all the various additional statutory provisions involving DUI that Illinois law enforcement officers are required to enforce.
- ✓ The various penalty provisions for DUI related offenses and DUI related license provisions, including MCCD Licenses and the use and enforcement of the BAIID device provisions.
- ✓ Analysis of the impact of recent statute changes including the Medical Cannabis Statute and the Adult Use Cannabis Statute will be analyzed and discussed.
- ✓ Most recent case law concerning the enforcement of the DUI provisions will be
- ✓ identified, analyzed, and discussed.
