Course Description

This course will discuss and demonstrate the legal and safety issues related to custodial transport of prisoners outside of the correctional facility. This course will focus on the transportation methods of High Risk Custodial; Detainees; and Prisoners to and from correctional facilities. Attendees will learn about the Health Care Violence Prevention Act (210 ILCS 160/5) regarding transporting prisoners to and from a health care site, and the responsibilities to keep medical staff safe from the prisoner, as well as transporting prisoners to other facilities. Officer safety will also be a focal point of this hands-on training.

- Health Care Violence Prevention Act (210 ILCS 160/5)
- Outside Hospital Transport procedures / Restraint procedures of securing inmates to hospital bed.
- Security Staff qualification for transport
- Three phases of the prisoner transport
- Departure / Arrival Procedures

- Information Packets for Transport
- Travel Route / Plans
- Contraband / Personal Search, Vehicle Search and Restraint procedures for transport.
