Course Description

This Instructor Course will certify police officers to become Instructors for the Law Enforcement Medical Officer class. Law Enforcement Medical Officer Instructors will be able to teach officers within their department lifesaving medical techniques and help their officers stay current on the required Emergency Medical Response mandates each year.

This is a comprehensive training program that integrates first aid, safety education, and the Stop the Bleed initiative, focusing on injury treatment and emergency care for accidents, injuries and sudden illnesses.

Officers will acquire both essential lifesaving skills and effective teaching methods to disseminate this knowledge within their department. It is preferred that officers attending this course have some prior medical knowledge, but it is not a requirement.

Course Objectives

Class objectives include understanding:

- ✓ Application of basic life-saving skills
- ✓ Recognizing the signs and symptoms of medical issues
- ✓ Teaching methods to instruct other officers
- ✓ Becoming certified as a Law Enforcement Medical Officer Instructor
