Course Description

Illinois 95th **General Assembly Resolution 0051** requires *Manufacturer's* Certification on Elector-Muscular Disruption Technology (EMDT) Employed by Illinois Law Enforcement and Correctional Officers. <u>TASER</u> <u>International</u> requires that users of the TASER Conducted Electrical Weapon (CEW) device take a certification course prior to carrying the TASER. That certification expires one year from the date of issue.

This 3-hour class is for the re-certification of those officers who have previously received the full 8-hour <u>TASER</u> <u>Conducted Electrical Weapon Certification</u> class.

Course Objectives

- ✓ Understand how the TASER overrides & controls the central nervous system of a combative subject
- ✓ Know proper aiming & deployment of the TASER CEW
- √ Reload in a safe & proper manner
- ✓ Recognize when the TASER is armed & ready to deploy.
- ✓ Know how to install batteries
- ✓ Proper utilization of the laser sight
- ✓ Understand probe placement ballistics
- ✓ Demonstrate proper & accurate deployment of TASER cartridges in target
- ✓ Constitutional issues & case law on Use-of-Force & "Intermediate Weapons"
