Course Description							

This five-day, 40-hour Instructor course has been designed to train officers as instructors to teach Rapid Deployment/ Immediate Action tactics. The focus of this program will be to provide officers with the knowledge, specialized tactical skills, and associated printed materials they will need to develop, implement and teach Rapid Deployment/ Immediate Action classes.

Rapid Deployment/ Immediate Action is the swift and immediate deployment of law enforcement resources to an ongoing, life-threatening "Active Shooter" type of situation. These situations require immediate action and the rapid deployment of patrol officers. Failure to act could have catastrophic consequences resulting in death and/or great bodily harm to innocent people. These incidents may also necessitate the immediate and rapid deployment of patrol personnel to contain and prevent the escape of an armed and dangerous offender or rescue a downed officer and/or civilian.

Students will be learning skills and then performing teach backs to the rest of the class as they develop their instructor skills.

- Team formation, room clearing
- Conventional barricade hostage tactics
- · Integrated tactics: first responders, contact, and rescue teams
- Use of force and safety priorities
- Equipment and identification requirements
- Explosive devices
- Integration of multiple agency responses
- Verbal skills
