Course Description

This course is for Firearms Instructors only, who have had their Form C's approved by ILETSB. This course will measure practical marksmanship skills with the handgun and patrol rifle. The results of this course of fire will be documented with MTU 15. Firearms Instructors successfully completing the course will receive a state "Certificate of Qualification" meeting their annual qualification mandates. Firearms Instructors will successfully qualify on these two courses by scoring at least a 90% on each. The Course-of-Fire for this qualification is that which has been approved by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board (ILETSB) for both in-service handgun and patrol rifle qualifications. There will also be a review of the ILETSB Use of Force brochure covering statutory and constitutional considerations in peace officers use of deadly force in making arrest.

Course Objectives

Students must demonstrate:

- ✓ Safe weapon handling
- ✓ Firearms Instructors must qualify with a minimum of 90% with the handgun
- ✓ Firearms Instructors must qualify with a minimum of 90% with the patrol rifle.

Requirements

Officers participating in this qualification course must be ILETSB approved Firearms Instructors who have submitted their Form C and plan to teach or contract for MTU 15 as firearms instructors or are going to conduct in-service firearms qualifications and training at their departments via MTU 15.
